Important notice - please read

Due to an error in the processing of census data, the number of usual residents in the 'Religion not stated' category has been overestimated by a total of 62,000 for three local authorities: Camden, Islington and Tower Hamlets. Correcting the figures resulted in more usual residents in every stated religion category, approximately 14% in Camden, 9% in Islington and 10% in Tower Hamlets. The total numbers of usual residents in each local authority are not affected, just the distribution of usual residents across religion categories within these three local authorities, but with subsequent knock-on effects for other tables that include religion. The error occurred during the estimation of people who didn't respond to the census. Further information is posted on the ONS website.

Warning: ONS has only provided a correction for religion by age and sex at local authority level, meaning that any other published table that includes religion is presenting the old, uncorrected figures. It is not possible for users to apply a post-tabular correction across the range of census tables in a consistent manner and therefore the error remains in those published tables.
