## **Response**

The council holds the information requested. The answers to your questions are below.

I'm looking for a list of all the venues, including pubs, bars, restaurants, hotels, care homes, cafes and any other businesses within the borough of Camden any other areas you may have jurisdiction over that may have a license for live music entertainment also known as 'TheMusicLicense' to be held in their premises.**

I can confirm that London Borough of Camden holds the information you requested. You can find this information on the online register, which include whether premises have a premises licence for regulated entertainment which is the music element, here:
