Thank you for your request for information dated 16/06/2021 about Healthy School Streets scheme. We have dealt with this under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Response

The council holds the information requested. The answers to your questions are below.

I would like to know when the Healthy School Streets scheme on Fitzjohns' Avenue, Netherhall Gardens and Maresfield Gardens (all NW3) started working,

The signs were installed in November 2020 and the camera enforcement for the scheme began on 8th March 2021. This was due to several factors such as issues with the cameras and also the pandemic/ school closures etc.

what is the reduction in term-time traffic achieved,

This information is not available as these counts will be analysed when the ETO is coming to an end, and the report and its findings will be published online.

how many penalty tickets have been issued for any contraventions and how many of these have been paid.

Please note that we are unable to calculate how many have been paid as many are going through appeals processes that have not yet expired.
