Thank you for your request for information dated 09/10/2020 about complaints of Anti-social Behaviour. We have dealt with this under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Response

The council holds some of the information requested. The answers to your questions are below. We have stated where we do not hold the information requested and why.

Please provide the following:

Information request 1 - How many complaints of Anti-social Behaviour have you received in the last 24 months?

October 28th 2019 – October 23rd 2020 there has been 2746 complaints to Community Safety's Partnership Information Hub.

Information request 2 - How do you record complaints? if you separate different types of Anti-social Behaviour such as environmental from neighbour disputes, please explain how.

We separate these reports by Ward e.g. Gospel Oak or Kilburn. We also separate the different types of anti-social behaviour by classification e.g. Noise, Drug Related or Threatening Behaviour.

Information request 3 - How many times have you issued a Community Protection Warning or a Community Protection Notice to manage Anti-social Behaviour in the last 24 months?

None. We do not issue CPN's or CPW directly, the Metropolitan Police issue them with our assistance.

Information request 4- How many Community Protection Notice breaches have you enforced in the last 24 months?

Where CPNs have been issued and been breached, the Council works with the Metropolitan Police to enforce. Enforcement takes a number of different approaches. We do not have a figure for complete numbers.

Information request 5- How many fixed penalty notices have you issued for breaches of a Community Protection Notice in the last 24 months?

None. We work closely with the Metropolitan Police where action is needed on individuals, supporting enforcement as necessary.

Information request 6 - How many times have you obtained an On-Notice Part 1 Anti-Social Behaviour Injunction in the last 24 months, where you are the applicant?

As above.

Information request 7- How many times have you obtained a Without Notice Part 1 Anti- Social Behaviour Injunction in the last 24 months, where you are the applicant?

As above.

Information request 8- How many Part 1 Anti-Social Behaviour Injunctions breaches have you enforced in the last 24 months?

As above.

Information request 9- How many Part 1 Anti-Social Behaviour Injunction breaches have resulted in a custodial sentence, suspended or otherwise?

This information is held by the Metropolitan Police.

Information request 10- How many partial closure orders have you obtained, where you are the applicant, in the last 24 months?

No Partial Closures obtained by Camden Council. Only assisted the Metropolitan Police in obtaining them.

Information request 11- How many full closure orders have you obtained, where you are the applicant, in the last 24 months?

12 Confirmed Full Closure Orders Obtained.

As some of the information not held is environmental we have to comply with a technicality and tell you that because it is not held it is excepted under Regulation 12 (4)(a). The Information Commissioner does not require a public interest test where the information is not held.
