Thank you for your request for information dated 03/03/2023 about **filming permits issued in named streets in NW1, revenue generated, parking bays displaced**. We have dealt with this under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 / Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Response

The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are as follows:

1. Please provide information on the number of filming permits you have issued in the past 2 years in Ivor Street, Bonny Street, Jeffery's Street, Jeffery's Place, Prowse Place, Royal College Street, Camden Street and Wilmot Place in NW1.

12 permits have been issued in the last 2 years on the roads listed.

2. Please include the revenue generated for the council and;

The total amount generated for Camden Council from the 12 permits referenced in Q1 is £35,302.70. This total amount declared for the council includes parking charges, highways fees and profit.

3. the number of residents parking bays that were displaced during filming. The number of resident parking bays that have been suspended across these streets

Across the 12 permits issued in the last 2 years as referenced in Q1, a total of 49 residents bays have been suspended during filming but 18 paid for bays have been made available as alternative parking for residents. Below indicates the number of bays per street:

Residents' bays suspended:

- Bonny Street - 6 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years

- Jeffrey's Street - 25 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Jeffrey's Place - 6 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Prowse Place - 12 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Royal College Street - 0 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Camden Street - 0 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Wilmot Place - 0 residents bays have been suspended across the 12 permits from the last 2 years

Bays provided for alternative resident parking bays

- Wilmot Place - 15 paid for bays have been provided for use by displaced residents across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Royal College Street - 5 paid for bays have been provided for use by displaced residents across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- Ivor Street - 2 paid for bays have been provided for use by displaced residents across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
- St Pancras Way - 6 paid for bays have been provided for use by displaced residents across the 12 permits from the last 2 years
